- Working knowledge of standard computer software packages, i.e., Word, Excel, Access

Job Responsibilities:

- Serve as primary FRC representative responsible for various private and institutionally owned timberland properties in Arkansas.
- Develop timberland management plans specific to client objectives.
- Implement silvicultural and management treatments associated with optimal stand development, asset protection, and client income objectives.
- Promote a positive image of FRC to clients, associates, contractors, and your community.
